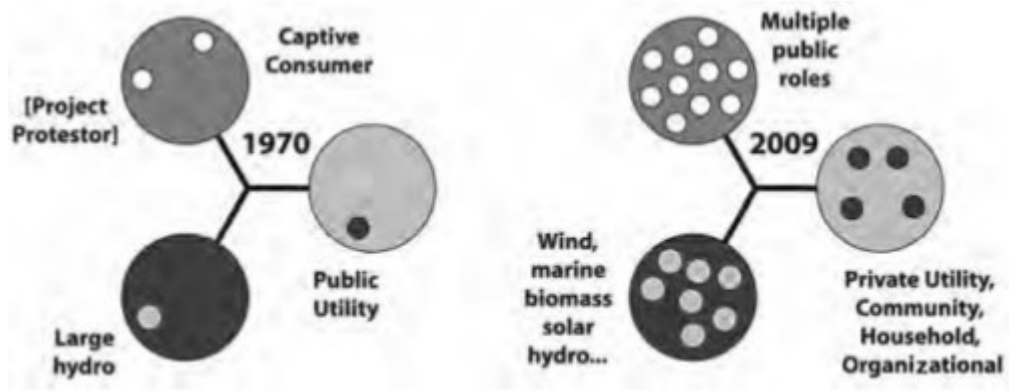

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# RES-E Support Schemes

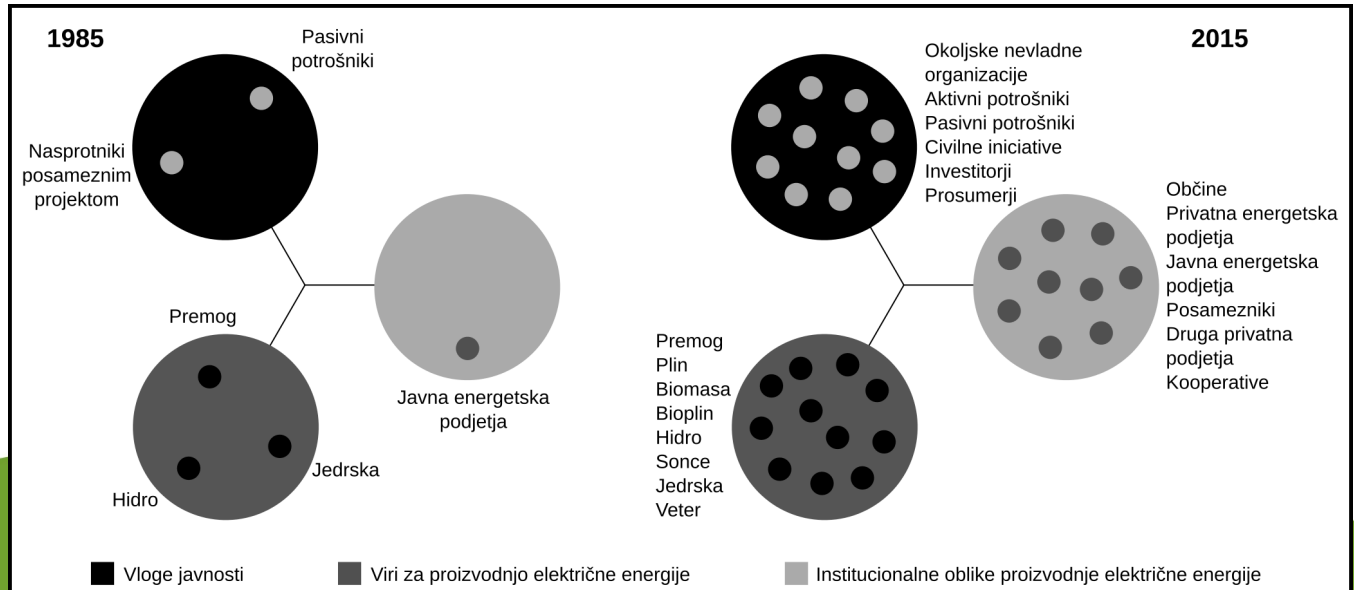
- FIT scheme ended in 2012. After that only small amount of new RES-E projects, negative connotation of RES
- New Energy Act (EZ-1) – 2014 introduces new tendering scheme for RES-E
- Introduction of "self-consumption scheme" - (net-metering) – in 2015
- Changes of "self-consumption scheme" in 2018 (allowing higher capacity of installations; allowing "community" projects; no yearly limitations for total capacity in the scheme)

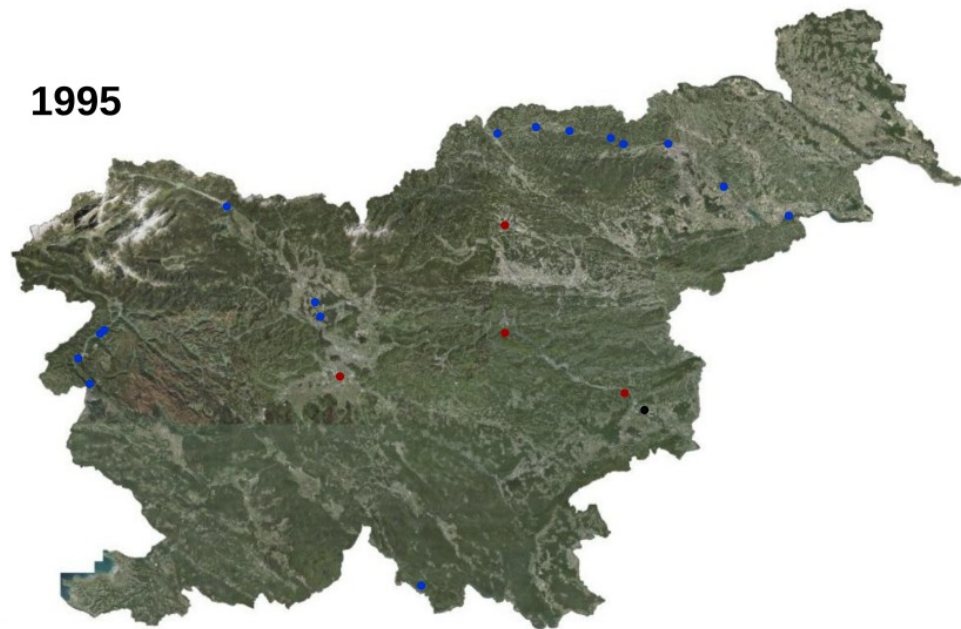

Figure 4.2 Comparing diversity in hardware, softwares and public roles between 1970 and 2009

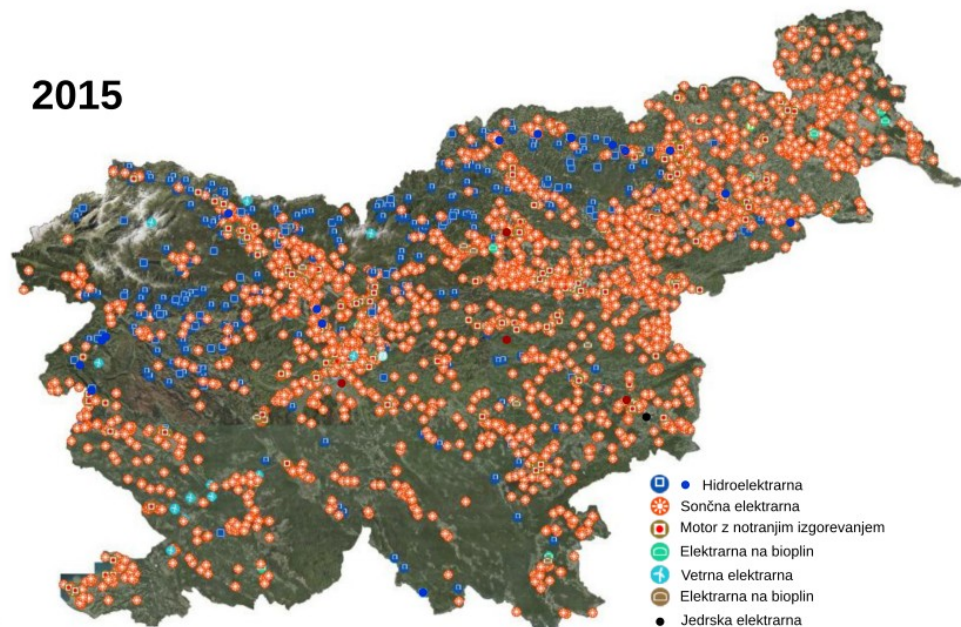

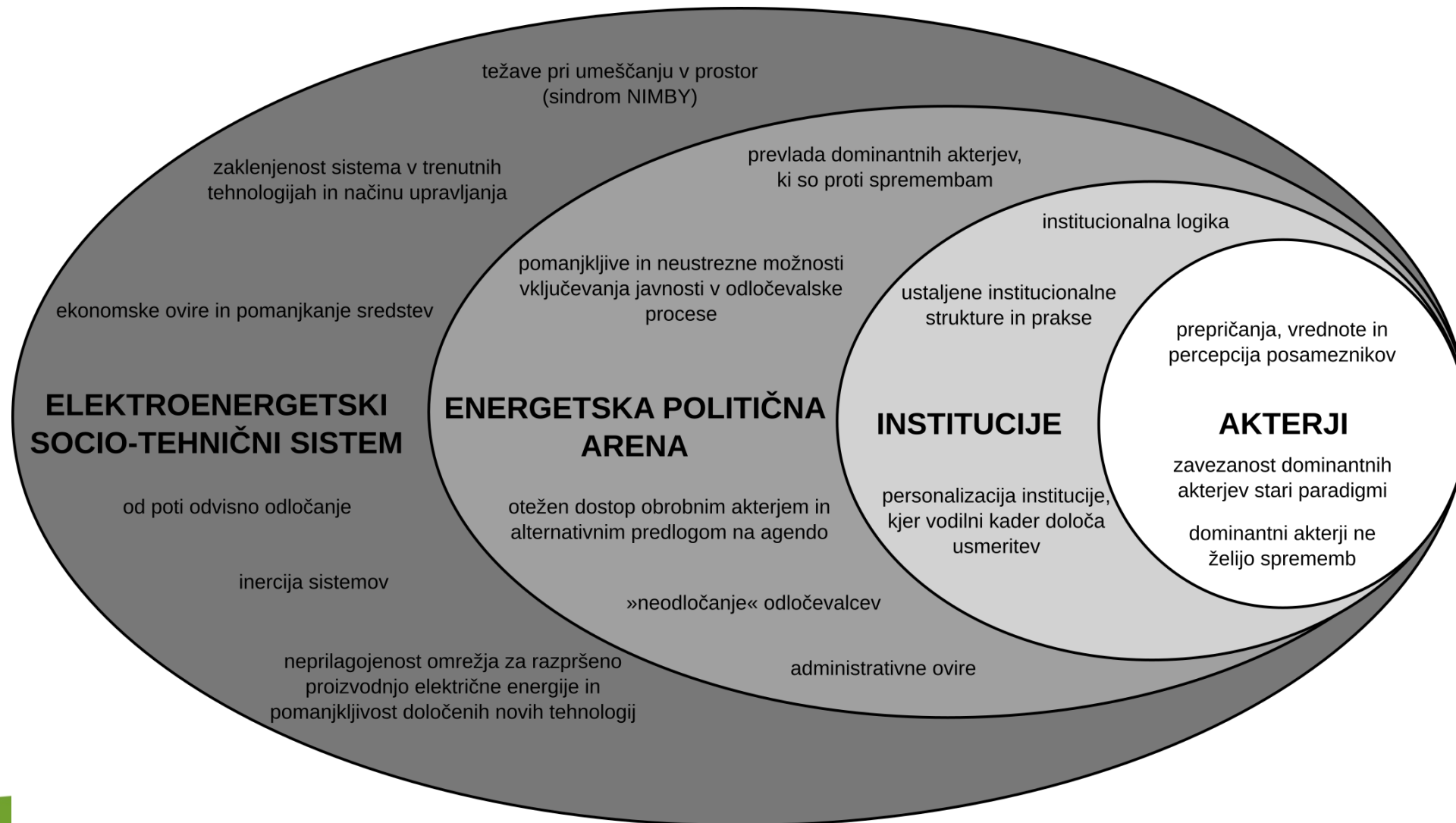

# Barriers for (policy) change



## Barriers for (policy) change

- Neglected aspects of: energy transition, community power, energy citizens, prosumers
- Decision-makers are not fond of changes (it is not certain if results will be positive or negative)
- Slow introduction of (new) knowledge
- Powerful actors in the energy arena want to keep their position = changes are not desirable
