

# October 2014 European Council conclusions

- RES target : “It will be fulfilled through Member States contributions guided by the need to deliver collectively the EU target without preventing Member States from setting their own more ambitious national targets”
- EE target: “ [...] This will be reviewed by 2020, having in mind an EU level of 30%.”
- EE target: “The Commission will propose priority sectors in which significant energy-efficiency gains can be reaped, and ways to address them at EU level.”
- RES and EE targets: “Targets will not be translated into nationally binding targets.”


