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

- → proposing and acting for ecologically sound and socially equitable societies

Degrowth is

A critic of the ideology of growth (Diagnosis + Prognosis)

→ to stay well you need more (main common sense)

Degrowth is

An ensemble of discourses and practices aiming to steer the transformation of the society while putting the sustainability of life at the centre (Therapy)

→ live simply so others (H and non-H) may simply live (main common sense)



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










Nowadays towards the peak-oil (EROI= 20)




Aim:

GDP 1. 075 Trillion

Public Debt/GDP = 103%, Plus 55% since 2008: mostly bailout

Private Debt/GDP= 321%



Degrowth therapy Post Normal Science (PNS)



(PNS) is a problem-solving strategy to be used "when facts are uncertain, values are in dispute, stakes are high, and decision urgent"

(Funtowicz and Ravetz 1994)

Degrowth therapy Post Normal Science calls for

- the politicization of science for governance, against the increasing technocratization of politics
- new models of democratized knowledge production
- "extended peer community" in environmental, development and equity policy debates

Degrowth therapy Post Normal Science call for









shift of decisions from 'communities of experts' to decisions by 'expert communities' (D'Alisa et al. 2010)

Degrowth therapy Post Normal Science

- 1) In international conferences we attempt to do away with ex-cathedra experts and create an "extended peer review community" for degrowth research
- 2) the eradication of the monopoly of experts from collective decision-making








GDp growth and GDP per capita

Work sharing and reduction of working hours (I)




Decreasing the working time (daily, weekly, monthly or working life?)



Work sharing and reduction of working hours (III)

Kallis et al. 2013 Friday off Reducing working time in Europe

- reduction without a decline in wages
- additional policies to shift incentives in favor of convivial, environmentally-friendly consumption
- implemented initially as measure to relieve unemployment

Basic income and ceiling income for...



Establish a ratio between Higher Salary and Lower Salary


e.g. HS > LS (30 times)

LS= 400 – 600 €/month HS= 12.000 – 18.000 €/month

high tax rates do not appear to hurt the economy or make people lazy (1950)

low tax rates imply enjoyable booms followed by protracted bust,

and very high inequality (1920)

Basic income in Spain

Aracarons et al. 2014

Unconditional Basic Income (625€)

- The reform is self-financing
- The redistributive impact is very progressive
- More than 50% of population with low income gain
- tax rate not very high

Basic income and ceiling income in business



Example

Ratio HS/LS is 6.5

LS= 1200 **€/month** HS= 7800 **€/month**
